WHEREAS, This year's annual convention, FOBANA 2009, is being hosted by the Bangladesh Association, Houston, and takes place the weekend of July 4; and

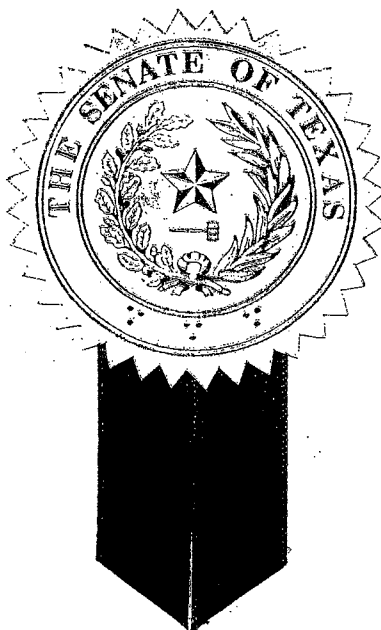
